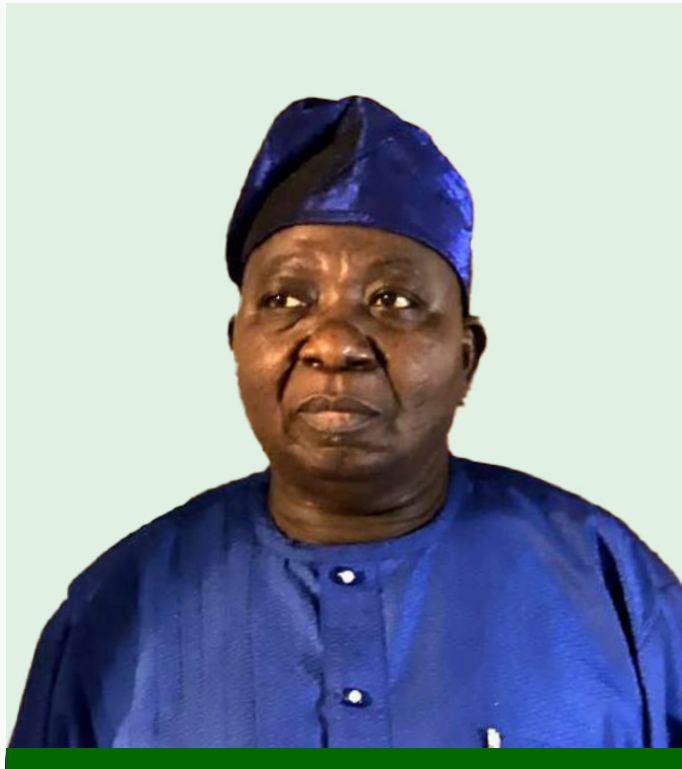

One of the key objectives of Community Builders for Africa (CBA) is to promote educational access and equity for underprivileged students across the continent.

In line with this core mission, CBA earmarked the sum of \$2,000 to be spent on our annual WAEC Fees Assistance Award project for eligible high school graduating students across Nigeria.

In the 2022 WAEC Fees Assistance Award, CBA was able to pay the WAEC registration fees for a total of 85 beneficiaries in seven states in Nigeria, covering Oyo, Ogun, Osun, Lagos, Ondo, Ekiti, and Kwara States.

We hope that this gesture will serve as an inspiration to the awardees and set them on a firm pedestal for academic advancement and lifelong success.

WAEC Fees Assistance Award Initiative

1. Project Approval

The 2022 WAEC Fees Assistance Award Initiative was officially approved during the organization's meeting in December 2021. Each member of CBA was allocated the opportunity to nominate five WAEC candidates from their selected local government area and state in Nigeria to receive financial assistance for their WAEC examination fees.

The initiative covered six states in Nigeria: Oyo, Osun, Ogun, Ondo, Ekiti, and Kwara, ensuring the program reached diverse communities across the region.

2. Project Implementation

CBA members collaborated with their respective home-based coordinators, engaging with school principals to:

- Determine candidate eligibility based on established criteria.
- Facilitate the selection and presentation process in alignment with CBA guidelines.

This grassroots approach ensured transparency and fairness in the award distribution, fostering strong community partnerships and effective program delivery.



3. Financial Summary and Breakdown

The total expenditure for the 2022 WAEC Fees Assistance Award Initiative amounted to \$2,000, which was utilized as follows:

1. WAEC Fees Payment:

- Each beneficiary received financial support to cover their WAEC examination fees.
- On average, the cost per candidate was approximately **\$23.50**.
- A total of **85** beneficiaries were supported across the six states, resulting in a total cost of **\$1,997.50**.

2. Administrative Costs:

- A minor portion of the budget (\$2.50) was used for administrative expenses, including communication, documentation, and coordination efforts with local school principals and home-based coordinators.

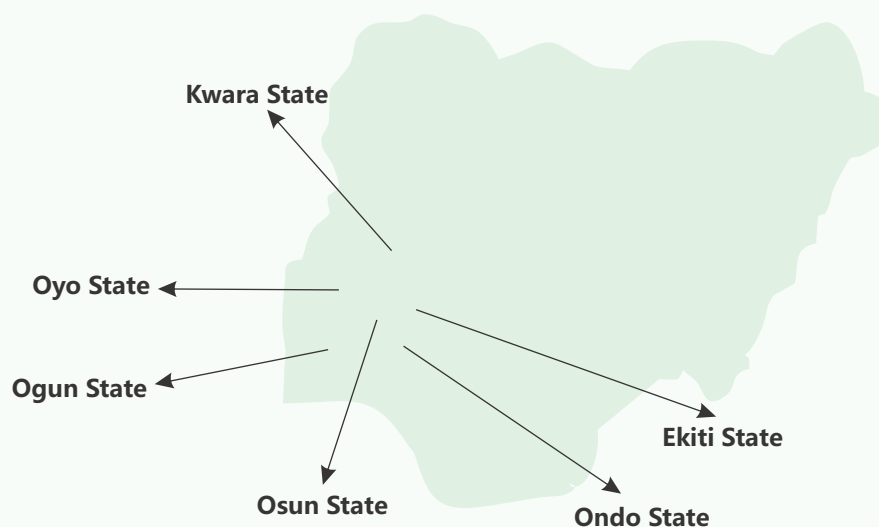
This transparent and targeted allocation ensured maximum impact with minimal overhead costs, emphasizing the organization's commitment to responsible resource management.

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4. Beneficiaries

A total of 85 WAEC candidates benefited from the 2022 WAEC Fees Assistance Award Initiative. These candidates were selected from 17 local government areas across six states:

- **Reduced Financial Burdens:** Families experienced significant relief from the cost of examination fees, enabling students to focus on their education without financial distractions.
- **Academic Empowerment:** Beneficiaries were motivated to excel academically, fostering increased dedication and a sense of achievement.
- **Community Engagement:** The initiative encouraged greater community participation in educational development, strengthening bonds between CBA members, schools, and local communities.

In instances where WAEC fees had already been covered by state governments, CBA held an emergency meeting to adapt to the initiative. The awards were redirected to support NECO candidates, ensuring the assistance reached those in need.

Some members of CBA made provision for sponsoring additional number of students from their personal purse to an additional 15 students which makes total beneficiary to be 100 recipients.
